Residents and property owners urged to consider applying for Board of Directors vacancy

Director Andy Rhodes announced last week his intent to resign from Castle Pines North Metropolitan District Board later this month. While we are deeply disappointed to see him go, his departure will create a vacancy on the five-member Castle Pines North Metropolitan District Board of Directors. The four remaining Board members intend to appoint a replacement as soon as practicable this month.

Upon filling the vacancy, the new appointee must be prepared to serve out the remainder of Director Rhodes term -- through the next regularly scheduled Board election in May 2012 -- and must also be prepared to stand for public election to a full four-year term of office at that time.

Serving on the Board of Directors is essentially a volunteer position that includes a small per-meeting stipend.

The Board typically meets the third Monday of each month at 7:00PM at the Castle Pines North Community Center, located at 7404 Yorkshire Drive. Board meetings often run until 10:00PM or later and are open to the public. In addition to regular monthly meetings, the Board holds special meetings on an as needed basis. Directors also periodically meet with constituents, staff and consultants; participate in various community meetings and events; and serve as fiscally responsible stewards of the community's drinking water, renewable water, wastewater, parks and open space assets and services.

Anyone interested in being considered for appointment to the Board must:

- own taxable real property and/or live within the Metropolitan District;
- be a registered Colorado voter; and
- plan to attend both regular and special board meetings.

The Board encourages interested parties to convey a letter of interest detailing any special qualifications and/or considerations, by no later than **12:00 noon on Monday, December 19, 2011**, to:
